

APPLICATION: TIMELINE

- · January 7: Application Opens
- · May 1: Deadline
- June 15: Recipients Notified





APPLICANT CONSIDERATIONS

- Must be enrolled as a full-time graduate or undergraduate student in the Fall of 2024
- · Recommended 3.5 cumulative GPA
- Detailed and thorough application responses
- · Phi Eta Sigma member





APPLICATION QUESTIONS

- · Plans for continued academic study
- Academic achievements, recognition, and awards



- · Specific contributions to Phi Eta Sigma
- · Campus Involvement
- Evidence of creativity, resourcefulness, innovativeness, or uniqueness
- Work experience



ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- · Letters of recommendation
- Save your responses in a document first, then copy and paste them into the online application for submission





- Mind your grammar, punctuation, mechanics, and style of writing
- Know the deadlines
- Discuss your application with your chapter advisor

ADVICE FROM THE COMMITTEE

- · Be proactive in planning
- · Use active adjectives and verbs
- Be specific in what YOU have done not just your chapter



- Don't assume the committee will know the significance of award - tell them why it is important
- Have recommendation letters
